**Liturgical Notes** – The congregation stands as soon as the music for the Gospel Acclamation (Alleluia) begins. Remember to bow during the Creed at the words "and by the Holy Spirit...and became man." It is correct to bow the head slightly at the mention of the name of Jesus in prayers and readings. Please remember to genuflect upon entering and leaving the pew.

It is helpful to accept the invitation to present the gifts of bread and wine, and the offerings of the congregation. These represent our work and our stewardship and self-offering to God. The ushers will be pleased to accept your help in this regard. To avoid distraction and to foster a spirit of reverence, please avoid trips to the lavatory and drinking fountain during Mass, except for necessity. Please replace books and cards in the pew holders and take belongings with you after Mass. Make an effort to be in the pew before Mass and do not leave before the priest does at the end of Mass. Everyone is doing well adjusting to the words and music of the Roman Missal introduced in late November 2011. Thank you for your kind attention to these notes.
