**Stand Against Assisted Suicide:** We have an opportunity to raise our voices against assisted suicide and to remind Congress that it has no place in health care. Con. Res. 80, a resolution expressing the sense of Congress that assisted suicide is a "deadly, discriminatory and non-compassionate practice."
